Our JEM website benefits from the efforts of many people who share the objectives of our ministry. The last person who touches posted contributions is the webmaster. Since its inception, the JEM website has experienced the prayers, thoughts and skills of several webmasters.

The current design began to take shape about three years ago when page design and format were changed for easier navigation by viewers. Input for changes came from JEM members, directors and interested viewers.

Contributors

Members and leaders of the village churches share pictures of rich activities happening in their churches, like special services, new experiences and special projects.

Since JEM activities include participants from Mexico, Yukon, BC, Alberta, Newfoundland and Labrador, the friends and workers in the ministry share pictures and stories.

How it happens

JEM uses a website builder called *Weebly* which provides pre-made page designs, and into which we place our content.

All contributors who share content as text or graphics for the website, direct them to Lanny Anderson, our vice-president and JEM website editor, who prepares most of these submissions into PowerPoint presentations, and places them into a drive shared with the webmaster.

From this shared drive, the webmaster transfers the presentation to the JEM website into its appropriate page. The website is hosted by Weebly, meaning that all the content is stored and made available to viewers world-wide by Weebly.
